The Resource Navigator walks alongside each person, guiding them on their unique dementia journey. The Resource Navigator's ongoing, regular contact creates seamless opportunities to assess unmet needs and assist the individual and their care partner create practical solutions and action steps. Assistance can include strategies to manage symptoms, facilitating transitions, connecting to relevant community resources, trying new communication techniques, or implementing a home safety change. There is no end to **Memory Link** services, they are available as long as the individual and their care partners want them.
