in Dementia Care

For first-year medical and DNP students

Shadow with geriatricians, neurologists, nurse practitioners, social workers, and others on the dementia diagnostic team to learn about the interdisciplinary approaches to caring for the geriatric population, particularly those with dementia, but also older patients with other chronic conditions. Spend time with other health care providers and learn about resources such as adult day centers, hospice care, and Adult Protective Services.

Rotations: Memory diagnostic clinics located within Tribal, Tribal organizations, underserved, or rural sites. And hybrid visits with other community dementia-care providers.
